Enhancements & Bug Fixes

General

- Search: applications with no licensed assets can now be found.
- Decisions: The Government of Alberta is copied on the email notification when cancelling the disposition.
- The subject line for landowner letters is properly populated.

Applications

- Public Notice of Application (PNOA) Counter:
 - If no statement of concern (SOC) is received, certificates for baseline applications will be issued in 31 days from the date of application, instead of 30, to accommodate the SOC process.
 - The number of days remaining is displayed correctly: 30 days counted down from the date received. The days remaining will no longer reset when the application is transferred or if the status changes.
- Draft applications no longer expire.

Submissions

- The link to the Phase 1 ESAs has been fixed; Phase 1 ESAs uploaded to OneStop before March 31, 2017 are now displayed.
- Draft submissions no longer expire.
- In the disposal section of the Phase 1 ESA, when asked "Has the site been used for drilling waste disposal more than once?" and the user selects "no," the selection will remain "no." The selection is also reflected correctly in the printed pdf.

Applications

PNOA counter

The display of the days remaining is now correct. Business rules are run again after the PNOA period expires to align with the SOC process. The reclamation certificate will be issued for baseline applications on day 31 if no SOC was filed.
