Invitation for Feedback on Draft *Directive XXX: Diagnostic Fracture Injection Test Submission and Content Requirements*

The Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB) is inviting stakeholder feedback on *Directive XXX: Diagnostic Fracture Injection Test Submission and Content Requirements*. This directive sets out submission and content requirements for diagnostic fracture injection tests used to obtain geomechanical information. It does not apply to diagnostic fracture injection tests conducted in accordance with *Directive 40: Pressure and Deliverability Testing Oil and Gas Wells*.
