### **1 DECISION**

Having completed a review of the application, the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (EUB/Board) hereby approves Application No. 1481859.

### **2 INTRODUCTION**

#### **2.1 Application**

Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL) applied, in accordance with Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act*, for approval to construct and operate a pipeline for the purpose of transporting natural gas from an existing well located at Legal Subdivision (LSD) 16 of Section 23, Township 46, Range 26, West of the 4th Meridian, to a pipeline tie-in point at LSD 13-22-46-26W4M. The proposed pipeline would be about 2.87 kilometres in length and would transport natural gas containing a maximum hydrogen sulphide concentration of 0.00 moles per kilomole (0.0 per cent).

#### **2.2 Intervention**

Donald Cummings, owner and resident of lands on which the pipeline is proposed to be located, opposed approval of the pipeline application. Mr. Cummings's concerns were related to pipeline construction, agricultural impacts, and property value.

### **3 DISCUSSION**

The Board had scheduled a public hearing to commence on April 19, 2007. Subsequent discussions between CNRL and Mr. Cummings resulted in an agreement. On April 16, 2007, the EUB received a withdrawal of objection from Mr. Cummings. The Board has determined that the application meets all the applicable EUB requirements. The Board has therefore cancelled the hearing and will issue the necessary approval in due course.
