1 RECOMMENDATION

The Board Member has been advised by the applicant that the line on the pipeline licence, which would have been the subject of the Board's review, will not be constructed. It is the Board member's recommendation that further review of this licence is therefore not required.

2 INTRODUCTION

2.1 Application

On July 19, 2006, the Board approved Application No. 1470827 and issued Pipeline Licence 30499, Line 4, to Canadian Natural Resources Limited, pursuant to Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act*.

Application No. 1470827 was to build a pipeline from an existing well located at Legal Subdivision (LSD) 14, Section 28, Township 29, Range 1, West of the 4th Meridian, to a pipeline tie-in point at LSD 10-17-49-1W4M. The proposed pipeline would have been 4.81 kilometres (km) in length and would have transported natural gas containing no hydrogen sulphide. The proposed pipeline was to be located 3.4 km south of Lloydminster.

2.2 Intervention

On October 30, 2006, the Board received correspondence from Gwen Misiak requesting that a review hearing be held, pursuant to Section 39 of the *Energy Resources Conservation Act*, to consider the Board's decision to issue the pipeline licence. The request for review related to the location of the pipeline on Ms. Misiak's land.

3 DISCUSSION

On May 4, 2007, the applicant notified the EUB that it would not be proceeding with the construction of the pipeline approved under Pipeline Licence 30499, Line 4, pursuant to Section 5(2) of the *Pipeline Regulation*. Accordingly, a public hearing is not necessary.
