1 DECISION

Having received Applications No. 1579701 and 1579704, noting that they meet Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) requirements, and noting the receipt of a confirmation of nonobjection from the intervening party, the Board hereby approves Applications No. 1579701 and 1579704.

2 INTRODUCTION

2.1 Applications

ARC Resources Ltd. (ARC) submitted two applications, in accordance with Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act*, for approval to construct and operate two pipelines for the purpose of transporting oil effluent with no hydrogen sulphide from Legal Subdivision (LSD) 5, Section 28, Township 49, Range 6, West of the 5th Meridian, to LSD 9-28-49-6W5M and from LSD 8-32-49-6W5M to LSD 16-32-49-6W5M. The length of the proposed pipelines would be about 1.55 kilometres (km) and 0.86 km respectively, with an outside diameter of 85.9 millimetres. The proposed project would be located about 8.9 km northeast of the Town of Drayton Valley.

2.2 Intervention

Randy Robb, owner of the lands where one of the proposed pipelines would be located and an occupant of the lands where the second proposed pipeline would be located, filed objections to the subject applications dated September 9, 2008, and November 14, 2008. Mr. Robb raised various concerns relating to the subject applications.

3 DISCUSSION

ARC engaged in an ERCB-facilitated appropriate dispute resolution meeting with Mr. Robb on December 2, 2008. The meeting resulted in an agreement between the parties, and on January 21, 2009, the ERCB received a signed withdrawal of objection.
