APACHE CANADA LTD.**APPLICATIONS FOR A WELL, PIPELINES AND FACILITY****Decision 2010-033****DAVEY FIELD****Applications No. 1648281, 1639107, and 1639117**

1 DECISION

Having confirmed the applications are technically complete and on receipt of a written non-objection from the party who triggered the hearing of the above applications, the Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) has cancelled the hearing of and hereby approves the Applications No. 1648281, 1639107, and 1639117.

2 APPLICATIONS

Apache Canada Ltd. (Apache) applied for licences for a well and a multiwell gas battery at Legal Subdivision (LSD) 6, Section 19, Township 33, Range 27, West of the 4th Meridian. Apache also applied for approval to construct and operate three pipelines for the purpose of transporting natural gas. There would be no hydrogen sulphide associated with these facilities.

Howard, Anne, and Glen Schafer (the Schafers) filed an objection to the applications.

3 DISCUSSION

The Board was scheduled to hold a public hearing in Olds, Alberta commencing on November 24, 2010, before Board Member Gordon Miller (Presiding Member).

Following participation in the ERCB Appropriate Dispute Resolution program, Apache and the Schafers reached an agreement on their own. On October 4, 2010, the ERCB received a signed non-objection from the Schafers confirming they no longer have objections to the applications.

Accordingly, the public hearing to consider the applications is cancelled.
