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**1 DECISION**

Having received Application No. 1639824, noting that it meets the Energy Resources Conservation Board's (ERCB/Board) requirements, and noting the receipt of a confirmation of nonobjection from the intervening parties, the Board hereby approves Application No. 1639824.

**2 APPLICATION**

Cequence Energy Ltd. (Cequence) submitted an application in accordance with Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act* for approval to construct and operate a pipeline for the purpose of transporting natural gas from Legal Subdivision (LSD) 16, Section 18, Township 79, Range 11, West of the 6th Meridian, to pipeline tie-in point at LSD 11-19-79-11W6M. The proposed pipeline would be about 1.84 kilometres (km) in length with a maximum outside diameter of 168.3 millimetres and would transport natural gas with a maximum hydrogen sulphide concentration of 5 moles per kilomole (0.5 per cent). The proposed pipeline would be located about 30 km northeast of Pouce Coupe.

**3 DISCUSSION**

The Board was scheduled to hold a public hearing of the application in Bonanza, Alberta, on March 1, 2011, before Board Member George Eynon, P.Geol. (Presiding Member) and Acting Board Members Robert Willard P.Eng. and Jeffrey Gilmour, B.A. LL.B. On January 27, 2011, the Board received a withdrawal of objection from Klimek Law on behalf of the interveners. Accordingly, the public hearing to consider the application was cancelled.
