1 DECISION

The Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) has accepted a request from Husky Oil Operations Limited (Husky) to withdraw Applications No. 1609853, 1609729, and 1622441. Accordingly, a public hearing is no longer required and the Board has cancelled the hearing.

2 APPLICATIONS

Husky applied for licences for a well and facility at Legal Subdivision (LSD) 7, Section 4, Township 33, Range 28, West of the 4th Meridian. Husky had also applied for approval to construct and operate a pipeline for the purpose of transporting gas from LSD 7-4-33-28W4M to a pipeline tie-in point at LSD 8-4-33-28W4M. There will be no hydrogen sulphide associated with gas production from these facilities.

An objection to the applications was filed by Catherine Ellis, Gordon Ellis, and Lorraine Ogilvie-Ellis. On March 8, 2010, a signed withdrawal of objection was received by the ERCB from the intervening parties. The applicant engaged in the ERCB Appropriate Dispute Resolution program with the intervener on June 23, 2009 and November 26, 2009. Husky and the interveners continued in discussions and the Board accepted a request to reschedule the hearing to provide an opportunity for the parties to reach an agreement on their own.

3 DISCUSSION

The Board was scheduled to hold a public hearing in Olds, Alberta, on March 23, 2010, before Board Member George Eynon, P.Geol. (Presiding Member), Board Member Theresa Watson, P.Eng., and Acting Board Member Donna Tingley.

On March 11, 2010, the applicant notified the ERCB that it was withdrawing Applications No. 1609853, 1609729, and 1622441, pursuant to Section 21 of the *Energy Resources Conservation Board Rules of Practice*, and the Board accepted the withdrawal of the applications.
