1 DECISION

Having received Application No. 1644910, noting that it meets Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) requirements, and noting the receipt of a confirmation of nonobjection from the intervening party, the Board hereby approves Application No. 1644910.

2 APPLICATION

EnCana Corporation (EnCana) submitted an application in accordance with Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act* for approval to construct and operate a pipeline for the purpose of transporting natural gas from Legal Subdivision (LSD) 1, Section 32, Township 24, Range 25, West of the 4th Meridian, to a pipeline tie-in point at LSD 11-27-24-25W4M. This pipeline would be about 2.79 kilometres (km) long. EnCana has also applied to construct a contingency pipeline from LSD 4-33-24-25W4M to LSD 3-33-24-25W4M, blind-end to blind-end. This pipeline would be about 0.83 km long and remain discontinued until production places constraints on existing pipeline infrastructure, requiring it to become operational. Both pipelines would have a maximum outside diameter of 273.1 millimetres, transport natural gas with no H₂S, and operate as level-1 pipelines. The east end of the natural gas pipeline would be located about 370 metres north of the town of Strathmore.

An objection to the application was filed by Jim and Kristin Vergouwen.

3 DISCUSSION

The Board scheduled a public hearing in Calgary, Alberta, to be held on June 28, 2011, before Board Member T. L. Watson P.Eng. (Presiding Member), Board Member T. C. Engen, and External Acting Board Member H. R. Heffler M.Eng.

On June 23, 2011, the ERCB received a signed withdrawal of objection from Jim and Kristin Vergouwen. Accordingly, the public hearing was cancelled.
